- The three key school rules which apply to all members of our community are clearly stated in the diagram on the back of this leaflet.



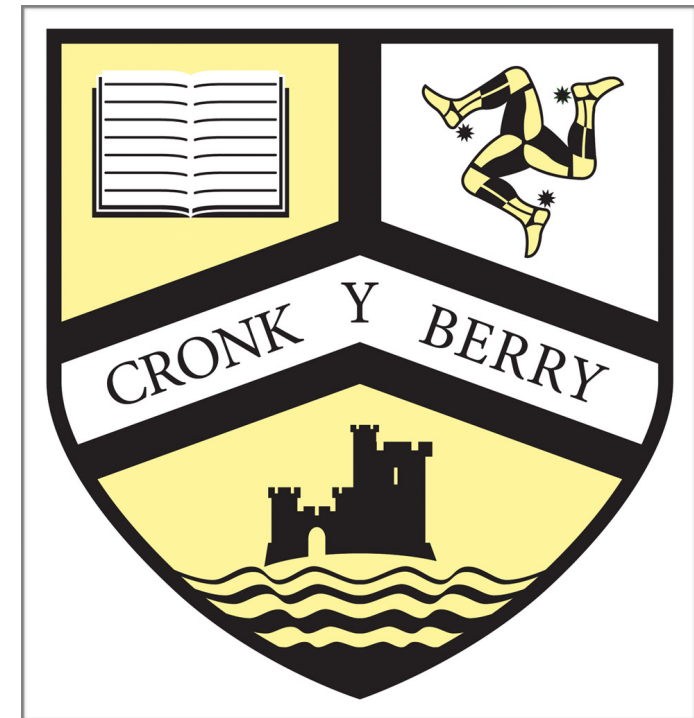
Our Home School Partnership Policy encapsulates our belief that parents are a child’s first and most important educators.

As a school, we will try our best to:

- Care for pupils' safety and happiness and treat them with respect.

- Provide parents and carers with regular information including newsletters and meetings to discuss progress.
